



BALTIC SEA CLUB CUP 2021

REGULATION

1. Organization

- 1.1. The tournament is organized by Estonian Petanque Federation in cooperation with Latvian, Lithuanian and Finnish federations.
- 1.2. Date: 25-26 September 2021.
- 1.3. Place: Harku Petangihall (Pikk 19, Harku, Estonia)
- 1.4. Referee: competent.
- 1.5. List of players must be sent at least four days before the tournament to email juhatus@petanque.ee.
- 1.6. Contacts: Lithuania - Mindaugas Matulionis, Estonia - Meelis Münt, Finland - Jari Eronen, Latvia - Edgars Silovs.
- 1.7. Participation fee: 25€ per person (lunch included).

2. Participants

- 2.1. Latvian, Lithuanian, Estonian and Finnish best clubs participate in the tournament. 2 clubs from each country.
- 2.2. It is possible for other countries to take part in the tournament if there is a free place.

- 2.3. Each club is allowed to have maximum of 8 players, at least 2 of them must be women (e.g. 6 men and 2 women or 5 men and 3 women). If a club have only 6 players then there must be only one female player.
- 2.4. All players in a team need to wear the same uniform.
- 2.5. Teams (clubs) limit is 8.
- 2.6. Smoking, consuming alcoholic drinks and drugs, and use of mobile devices is prohibited.

3. Playing System

- 3.1. Clubs play round-robin games in 2 groups and play-off games.
- 3.2. Club placement in the group will be drawn before tournament.

4. Rules

- 4.1. All games are played according to the FIPJP (Fédération Internationale de Pétanque et Jeu Provençal) approved petanque game rules.
- 4.2. Field size must match CEP (Confédération Européenne de Pétanque) rules (3x13).
- 4.3. In the case of a tie game, teams play an extra end.
- 4.4. Game time for each game round is different:

Singles - 40 minutes plus additional jack

Doubles - 50 minutes plus additional jack

Triples - 60 minutes plus additional jack
- 4.5. In SINGLES every team needs to mark 6 players who will play and at least one of them must be a woman.
- 4.6. In DOUBLES every team needs to mark three doubles - one mixed (man and woman) and one freely formed double.
- 4.7. In TRIPLES every team needs to mark two triples - one mixed and one freely formed triple.
- 4.8. In DOUBLES and TRIPLES teams are allowed to change one player but they need to announce it to the referee and the opponents.

5. Points and Winner

- 5.1. Every win in singles gives 2 Game points (max 12pt).
- 5.2. Every win in doubles gives 3 Game points (max 9pt).
- 5.3. Every win in triples gives 5 Game points (max 10pt).
- 5.4. The team with the most Game points at the end of the match is awarded 3 Match points.
- 5.5. The team that have the most Match points is the winner of a group.
- 5.6. If two or more teams have the same total number of Match points in a group, the following formula will be applied to decide the overall results:
 - 1) The sum of Game points only between those teams (5.1., 5.2., 5.3.);
 - 2) The difference of small points (game results (13:1 or 9:8)) between those teams;
 - 3) The total small points (game results (13:1 or 9:8)) difference between all teams.

Issues not covered by this Regulation shall be governed by the EuroCup Qualification Rules.
