



## Invitation to the Euro-Pétanque (Corona) Precision Shooting challenge for teams



During the lockdown of Denmark, due to the Covid-19 outbreak, pétanque players have competed in a virtual shooting competition. This competition quickly evolved into an international tournament with participations from mostly the Nordic countries, based on livestreaming the games on Facebook.

Today, the Danish Pétanque Federation, in partnership with the CEP, are organising the Euro-Pétanque (Corona) Precision Shooting Challenge and invite all European federations to participate with one or two teams.

A team will consist of:

- 1 Male player
- 1 Female player
- 1 Espoir player (male or female)
- 1 Junior player (male or female)
- 1 Veteran player (+55 male or female).

The Euro- Pétanque (Corona) Precision Shooting Challenge will take place “virtually” via Facebook, and each player will have to stream their match directly to the page created by the Danish Pétanque Federation for the event.

The challenge takes place from July 1st, when players have 2 days to complete their round as per the instructions.
